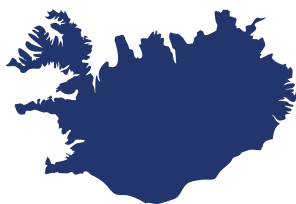


## LATE 19th CENTURY
